VISITATION



Loved ones and caregivers may enjoy in-suite, outdoor, and window visits with residents, depending on vaccination and community status.

Visitors are asked to call ahead before they plan a visit to a community.

*An open modified-operating community is determined by having 14 consecutive days with zero active, confirmed cases of COVID-19.

A closed community is determined by having two or more cases of COVID-19 that cannot be linked.



There may be adaptations to activities and dining depending on resident vaccination status and local, county, or state/provincial guidelines. Masks are worn in common areas and may be removed when fully vaccinated residents are together.
